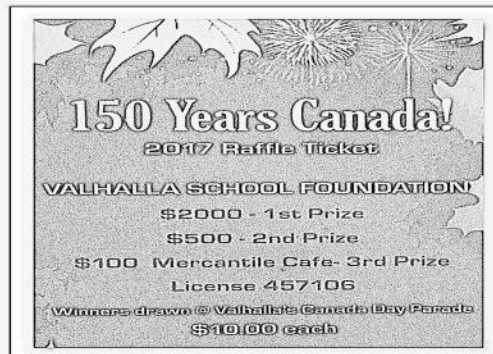
Once all our existing families have registered (by April 12), the school will be considering wait list students for any class spaces that remain available.

Parent Information Night: Life's Challenges in School

What are students facing everyday that distract from being everything that they can be? This presentation will peer into the lives of today's youth and provide an understanding of the pressures they face everyday. Participants will also learn how students struggle to fit in with peers ... while dealing with bullying, harassment, stereotypes, teasing, rumours, drugs, depression, suicide, violence, family issues, and more. Also the power of the words we use everyday, respecting others and self respect, body image and eating disorders, texting, sexting, the impact of media including video games on today's youth and the importance of honest communication.

Parents will view a 15 minute segment of the "Surviving High School" video which is the last portion of a 60 minute version that their children viewed. You will witness what 11 teens can accomplish when they take what they have learned, through a month long process, back to their school where they invite 50 peers, teachers and administrators to participate in a daylong event. You will also hear what students around Canada are saying about their lives and some of their fears, concerns and struggles.

A component of this presentation also includes charges under the **Criminal Code of Canada** that are applicable to those who chose to bully others in various ways.

Valhalla Community School will be holding a 2.5 hour Parent Information night on Thursday, April 27 (if we have enough interest). The session is entitled Life Synergy for Youth: Life's Challenges in Secondary School. **All parents of VCS students are strongly encouraged to attend.** This is a parent/guardian only session--grandparents, aunties, uncles, etc are most welcome to attend as well but we ask that your son or daughter does not attend with you.
