**School supplies:** We do ask that each student bring: a non-marking pair of running shoes for inside use, a back pack, a lunch kit. Please put your child's name on all their belongings.

**Resource Fee:** As a Public Charter School we do not charge tuition fees. Like other public schools, we do charge a fee for materials provided for the student's personal use. The fees charged are on a cost shared basis between the parent/guardian and the Valhalla Community School. Fees are as follows; Resource fee for Kindergarten \$75.00 per year, Grades 1 to 9 \$100 per year and textbook rental for grades 1 to 9 \$50.00 per year. A family total maximum is \$300 per family per year. Fees may be paid in installments or in cases of financial hardship a waiver may be made. Please contact the office for more information.
