

Please join us for the Annual General Meeting of the Valhalla School Foundation which will be held on Tuesday, March 23, 2010 at 7 p.m. in the Valhalla School Gym.

At this time, one new Director will need to be elected. A Director must be 18 years of age or older, a parent or guardian of a child attending the Valhalla Community School or a community member who is supportive of the mission of the VCS. Staff currently employed by the VCS may not be a Director. Also, a member should not hold both a School Council Executive position and a Charter Board Director position at the same time. Directors are elected for a 3 year term.

The Board is accountable to the Minister of Education to ensure that the School operates in accordance with the School act and that students are learning in accordance with the Charter goals and objectives. Directors shall be guided by the philosophy, mission, and vision of the VCS Charter. Directors are expected to attend one regular monthly meeting (usually about 3 hours); attend periodic special meetings and sessions; and carry out various other committee responsibilities as required.

Nominations for the vacant Director position will be taken from the floor at the annual meeting. The members present at the annual meeting will have one vote per member. Members eligible to vote shall be parents or guardians of any children currently attending the school, and community members living within the designated boundary.
