
Speech Competitions This Week!


Students in all grades are beginning to prepare for the VCS annual speech competition. The competition will be held on February 6, 2014 at 7pm.

Valhalla School Foundation Notice

The VSF Annual General Meeting has been set for Thursday, March 13 at 7 p.m. in the Viking Room.

Three directors are coming to the end of their current terms and our interim position will need to be elected at that time, as well. Brenda Kjemhus, John Moutray, and I have all agreed to let our names stand for another term. In addition, Tracy Campbell has agreed to let her name stand for the position she has been filling in the interim.

It is still possible for interested individuals to put their names in for election as a charter board director. According to our bylaws, a director must be 18 years of age or older, a parent or guardian of a child attending the VCS or a community member who is supportive of the mission of the VCS. Staff currently employed by the VCS may not be a director. Directors are elected for three year terms.

An information package for potential nominees can be picked up at the office or is available on our website. 
Bus Driver's Corner

The Valhalla School Foundation Board of Directors has adopted a change to the winter weather clothing policy.

All students riding on school buses during the winter months shall be required to wear winter footwear and outer wear and to carry with them headgear and gloves or gloves or mitts, effective Nov1 to Mar

It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that their children comply with the requirements, if a student is not wearing, or does not have in their possession, appropriate clothing suitable for the weather conditions the bus driver shall advise the parent, principal and document the discussion. In a situation that the Principal determines to be of significant risk to the student he/she may decide to keep the student at the school until they have appropriate clothing or the parent picks them up.

Accountability Pillar Surveys

Every year Alberta Education seeks information from students, teachers and parents about how their education experience is going. This is done through surveys. Students and teachers participate in on-line surveys at school.

The parent survey is scheduled to be fielded in January and February of 2014. These surveys are mailed from Alberta Education and returned directly to Alberta Education. The parent survey in small schools (fewer than 120 students in grades 4-12) includes parents of all students in grades 4 and above.

The more parents who participate in the survey, the more accurate the information is, so we encourage parents to complete and return the surveys as soon as possible once they've been received.

Registration Week

Administration has given a lot of thought into ways to strengthen the relationship between the school and our families. We want to be more intentional about working with families and having parents involved and active in the school.

Again this spring, we will be hosting a Registration Week. From April 22 to April 25, we will ask parents to book one evening appointment at the school to come in and complete the registration process for next year. From 4pm to 8pm each evening, bookings for 30 minute time slots will be available. More information will be released in upcoming newsletters.
