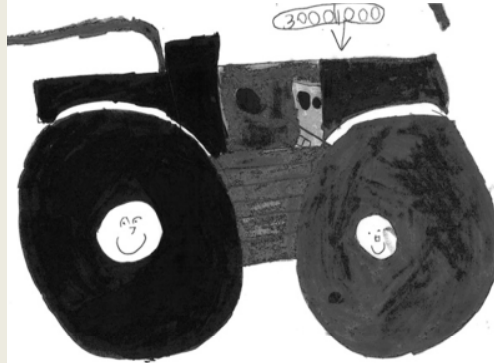

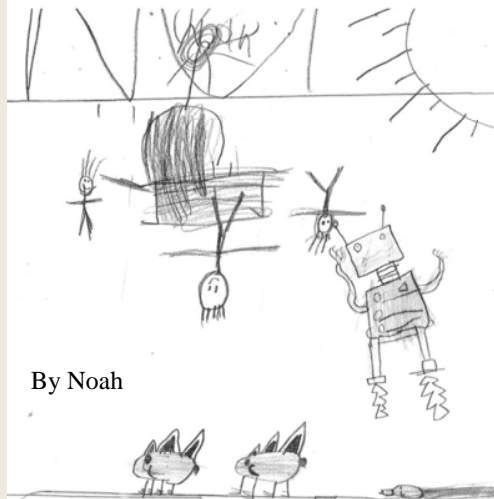

## Fund Raising!

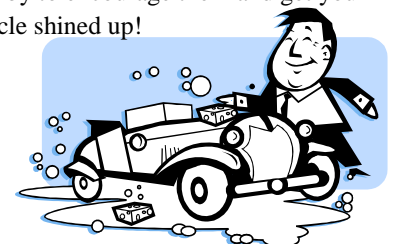

## Yearbook Group

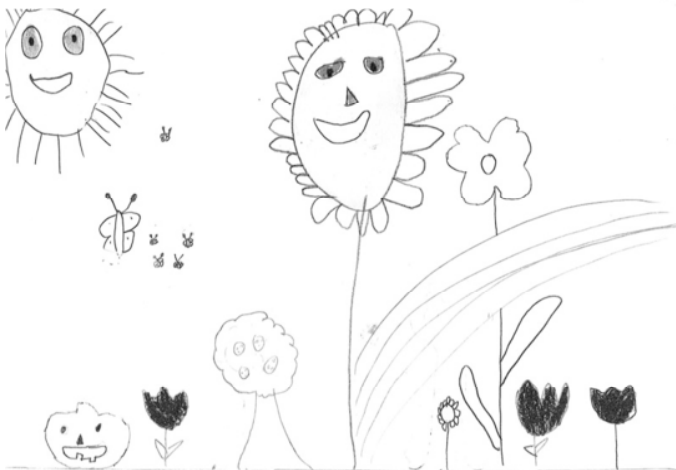
