- Treasurers Report Penny Braseth
 - ➤ Issues with QuickBooks means no report for this meeting. Will be updated and available at next meeting. Approximately \$12000 currently in bank account. Mostly already allocated.
- Signing authority to be given to Teresa Boucher, Penny Braseth & Mellissa Gilbert for the ATB account and Online account access.
 - F. Wright motioned, P. Braseth 2nd, AIF
- Council to purchase a partial laminating roll for the school
 - P. Braseth motioned to release \$135, F. Wright 2nd, AIF
- A couple of teachers have suggested chicken hatching for their classrooms. We have 2 options. Needed is an incubator, encloser and heat lamp.
 - ➤ Option 1 Rent for \$165/year would need a volunteer to pick up and take back. They give us the eggs, but we will have to return chickens and equipment when and where

- they tell us. We would still need to purchase an encloser, heat lamp, feeder & food on top of this fee.
- ➤ Option 2 Purchase incubator, encloser & heat lamp to keep at the school indefinitely. For an approximate cost \$500
 - F. Wright advised that she has an incubator that she is willing to lend to permanently loan to the school. All we would need to do is make an encloser or buy one online as a kit with heat lamp.
 - K. Strand motioned to release \$200 for chicken hatching, P. Braseth 2nd, AIF.
- ♦ Book Series Siha Tooskin Knows 8 books
 - Teaches about Native culture
 - Teresa downloaded the teachers guide previously
 - K. Strand motioned to release \$100 for purchase of book series, F. Wright 2nd, AIF.
- ❖ P. Braseth motioned to release funds for 2021/2022 Healthy Snack Fund, F. Wright 2nd, AIF.
- ❖ Hot Lunches Expectation is that school council will do as many hot lunches as previous year. How many lunches a month will depend on volunteers acquired. Hot lunch coordinator position still needs to be filled.
 - F. Wright motioned to release funds to facilitate hot lunches for every Friday students are in school, K. Strand 2nd, AIF.
- During our first breakfast for hot lunch, it was a challenge to accommodate enough pancakes at one time to get the lunches out quick enough. It is requested to get two grills to facilitate more of these in the future.
 - P. Braseth motioned to release \$200.00, K. Strand 2nd, AIF
- ❖ Payment of ASCA Fees for 2021/2022
 - K. Strand motioned to release \$100, F. Wright 2nd, AIF
- We need to decide when to hold our monthly meetings.

 - Meetings will rotate monthly going forward one meeting will be held at 10:30
 AM and then the next month @ 6:30 PM on the first Thursday of every month.
